

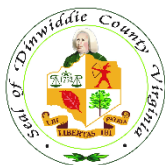

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## **MEMORANDUM**

SUBJECT: GIS NG911 Project

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### **Background**

The Commonwealth of Virginia has been planning for Next Generation 911 (NG911) for almost a decade. With advances in technology it is now time for Dinwiddie County 911 to move forward with deployment of NG911.

On November 1, 2018, Dinwiddie County received their PSAP/GIS Specific NG911 Migration Proposal from Virginia Information Technologies Agency (VITA). This proposal identified all requirements necessary to transition to NG911 and provided projected cost estimates and funding sources. In the Migration Proposal, Virginia Geographic Information Network (VGIN) provided detailed data analysis that revealed some required data updates needed to make it compatible with NG911 requirements.

GeoDecisions is the County's existing vendor for GIS data remediation and web mapping services.

### **Actions**

In May of 2019, the Board of Supervisors approved \$81,650 for this project as part of its FY 2020 CIP.

On December 11, 2019, Dinwiddie County received a quote from GeoDecisions to provide NG911 data development and remediation services for \$84,193.10; \$30,000 of which will be funded through the PSAP Grant Program with VITA. The project tasks are focused on evaluating, standardizing, updating, correcting and synchronizing key public safety data sets, including that of the GIS, MSAG and ALL.

### **Recommendation**

We recommend approval of the following resolution.

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Supervisors of Dinwiddie County, Virginia does hereby authorize and direct the County Administrator to execute the attached contract amendment with GeoDecisions to provide NG911 data development and remediation services in the amount of \$84,193.10.
