

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE
CODE OF THE COUNTY OF DINWIDDIE, 1985, AS AMENDED,
BY AMENDING CHAPTER 14, MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC, SECTION 14-6,
COURTROOM SECURITY FEE**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Dinwiddie County:

(1) *That the Code of the County of Dinwiddie, 1985, as amended, is amended by inserting the following language shown underlined and deleting the language shown in strikethrough:*

Section 14-6. Courtroom security fee.

Pursuant to § 53.1-120 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, there is hereby established a fee of \$20.00~~\$10.00~~ that shall be ordered as part of court costs imposed upon any defendant convicted in any criminal or traffic case in the district or circuit courts of the county. The fee shall be collected by the clerk of the court, who will remit the fee to the Treasurer of Dinwiddie County. The treasurer shall hold such fees subject to appropriation by the board of supervisors to the sheriff's office for the funding of courthouse security personnel, and if requested by the sheriff, for the funding of equipment and other personal property used in connection with courthouse security.
