IN RE: CHESTERFIELD AREA TECHNICAL SCHOOL-APPOINTMENT TO BOARD  
OF TRUSTEES.

Motion was duly made and carried that H. Barner Batte be  
appointed to the Chesterfield Area Technical College Board of  
Trustees from Dinwiddie County, for a term to be determined by the  
Board of Trustees but not more than four (4) years and not less than  
two (2) years.

IN RE: FUNDS - CHESTERFIELD AREA TECHNICAL COLLEGE.

The board having been requested by the Steering Committee  
to allocate \$15,000.00 to the Technical College and after lengthy  
discussion,

Motion was duly made and carried that said \$15,000.00 be  
given to the college for land acquisition and building construction.

IN RE: CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT - FRANCIS NEELEY.

Petition having been submitted by Francis Neeley to obtain  
a Conditional Use Permit to install a trailer on his three (3) acres  
of land on Rt. #656 and it appearing to the board that the neighbors  
approved by letter,


Motion was duly made and carried that a Conditional Use  
Permit be issued subject to approval by Commonwealth's Attorney.

IN RE: APPOMATTOX DAM HIGHWAY.

Mr. A. Mitchell Smith and A. Terrell Baskerville having  
attended a meeting in Richmond with the Highway Commissioners about  
constructing a bridge across the Appomattox Dam reported that the  
meeting was very informative. Mr. Smith reported that two (2)  
secondary roads and bridges would be flooded by water and that  
Chesterfield and Dinwiddie Counties would probably be asked to  
provide \$23,270.00 to the Appomattox River Water Authority to  
design and build the dam for possible bridge construction later,

Motion was duly made and carried that Mr. L. R. Treat, Jr.,  
District Engineer be invited to the regular May meeting to discuss  
same with the board.
