County Government Center Closes to the Public

DINWIDDIE, VA – In an effort to reduce the spread of COVID-19/Coronavirus, effective Wednesday, March 25, 2020, Dinwiddie County Government Offices will close to the public. This latest protective measure comes after Parks, Recreation and Tourism facilities closed last week.

County Administrator, Kevin Massengill advises “The only significant change to current operations is the lack of face-to-face interaction. Our employees remain committed to providing exemplary service to the public, and will continue to be available by phone and email to answer questions and conduct County business.” Massengill continued, “The Dinwiddie Health Department will remain open and can be accessed through the human services entrance to the Government Center, located on the ground level. This will be the **ONLY** entrance, and **ONLY** office, accessible to the public.”

Information on conducting business with Dinwiddie County:

Building Inspections/Planning & Zoning: 804-469-4500, option 6 – All correspondence will be conducted by phone, email or U.S. Mail. A drop box will be available at the building entrance for documents (plans, applications, permits, etc.). Items left in the drop box will be reviewed and any questions handled by phone. Documents will be returned by email or U.S. Mail after processing. A complete outline of adjusted operations for the Department of Building Inspections & Planning/Zoning is available on the County website under COVID-19 Updates.

Commissioner of the Revenue: 804-469-4500, option 4 - The Commissioner and her staff will be available by phone and email only. Citizens are encouraged to use the Treasurer’s drive-through drop box for correspondence with the Commissioner’s office. This drop box is located in the traffic loop at the main entrance to the

Government Center (facing the Courthouse). Documentation will be returned by email or U.S. Mail.

Department of Social Services: 804-469-4524 - Please contact the office by phone or by using the drive-through drop box located on the side of the building (nearest the Pamplin Building).

Treasurer: 804-469-4500, option 5 – The Treasurer and her staff will be available by phone and email. Citizens are encouraged to use the Treasurer’s drive through drop box, located in the traffic loop at the main entrance to the Government Center (facing the Courthouse). Documentation will be returned by email or U.S. Mail.
