IN RE: DEFERED PAYMENT PLAN GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES FOR COURT COSTS, FINES AND RESTITUTION

ORDER

The following are the time to pay guidelines for the total costs and fines in all cases assessed by this court.

<u>Amount of Fines & Costs</u>	<u>Time to Pay</u>
\$0 – \$500	6 Months
\$501 – \$1,000	1 Year
\$1,001 – \$3,000	2 Years
\$3,001 – \$5,000	3 Years
\$5,001 +	4 Years

There is a \$25 initial down payment for the first agreement and \$100 for the second. The court will allow a maximum of two deferred payment agreements. Upon the second default, matter will be referred to the collection agency, Virginia Department of Taxation. Guidelines for the second payment plan is at the discretion of the clerk or his appointee and will depend on amount previously paid.


If a time to pay for restitution is not previously ordered by the court it will be incorporated in the above stated guidelines. All restitution judgments rendered by the court shall be docketed in the Judgment Lien Docket Book. It is further ORDERED that, in all criminal cases coming before this court, unless directed otherwise, all payments made to court costs and restitution shall be first applied to the satisfaction of restitution, if any, and subsequently applied to court fines and costs.

This is order will become effective January 1st, 2009.
