DINWIDDIE COUNTY HIRES ZONING ADMINISTRATOR/PLANNER

~Christina Greene will be responsible for administering the planning related codes for Dinwiddie County and working with the planning staff to implement the Comprehensive Plan as well as assisting with the day-to-day Planning Department operations ~

DINWIDDIE - County Planning Director, Mark Bassett announced today the selection of Christina Greene as the County's new Zoning Administrator/ Planner.

Ms. Greene will review site plans for land development projects and subdivision plats, and assist with inspecting these projects during construction to ensure compliance with the applicable County regulations.

In addition, Ms. Greene will be working to implement the County's Comprehensive Plan and assist with the ongoing update of the Comprehensive Plan. Ms. Greene will also be actively participating with the day-to-day operations of the Planning Department.

Christina Greene is a graduate of King William High School as the valedictorian of her graduating class, and Ms. Greene received her Bachelor's of Arts Degree from Virginia Commonwealth University graduating Magna Cum Laude. In addition, Ms. Greene attended the Masters in Urban and Regional Planning program at Virginia Commonwealth University. Ms. Greene is also a certified combined Erosion and Sediment Control Administrator. In addition, Ms. Greene has done GIS analyst planning work with the Department of Game and Inland Fisheries. Most recently, Ms. Greene served as a Planner II with Middlesex County, Virginia.
