Subject: Qualified Residential Treatment Programs (QRTP) – Current Status

With the upcoming implementation of the Family First Prevention Services Act on July 1, 2021, several of you have asked if there was a listing of those residential programs (especially group homes) that are designated as a QRTP, and therefore eligible for continued Title IV-E funding.

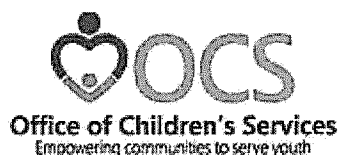
The Department of Social Services has established a listing on a website of those programs that have applied to be designated a QRTP. This list will be updated frequently as new applications are submitted and can be found here: https://familyfirstvirginia.com/foster_care/qrtp_applicants.html.

As a reminder, effective July 1, only those therapeutic group homes designated as a QRTP will be eligible for Title IV-E funds for children in foster care. Psychiatric

Residential Treatment Facilities will shift to all Medicaid funding (outside of CSA funded educational costs) regardless of QRTP status effective July 1.
