Subject: Proposed Transient Occupancy Rate Increase

Background:

House Bill 1214 from the 2020 session of the General Assembly became law and removed the five percent cap on the transient occupancy tax as it applied to Dinwiddie.

I was asked to prepare an amendment to the transient occupancy tax to increase the rate to eight percent (8%). At present the ordinance would designate that any amount of the tax above two percent (2%) would be designated and spent solely for tourism and travel, marketing of tourism or initiatives that, as determined after consultation with the local tourism industry organizations, including representatives of lodging properties located in the county, attract travelers to the county, increase occupancy at lodging properties, and generate tourism revenues in the county.

Action:

If the Board desires to adopt the attached ordinance, the following motion can be made:

“I move that the Board adopts the ordinance to increase the transient occupancy tax to 8% as presented.”
