CSA Community:

Pending the Governor's approval of the budget, please be aware of the following items that will likely have some impact on CSA provider costs:

1. Effective July 1, 2022, DMAS is authorized to continue to provide a 12.5% increase (over rates in effect prior to July 1, 2021) for community-based

behavioral health services which include intensive in-home, mental health skill-building, therapeutic day treatment, and crisis services). As CSA supports matching of Medicaid rates where possible and appropriate, this will impact these services for CSA-funded clients (non-Medicaid members). Remember, that these services are at the CSA community-based services rates, so the majority of any increase will be provided through state CSA pool funds. (HB 30 Budget Item 304 #22c)

2. Effective July 1, 2022, DMAS will adjust PRTF rates by 8.89% for inflation, and the rate ceiling for those facilities currently at the maximum rate will increase to \$460.89 per day. The primary impact on CSA will be in the local Medicaid match. (HB 30 Budget Item 304 #20c)

Again, these actions are contingent on the approval of the Governor. Should the Governor modify or fail to approve these actions, my office will let you know.
