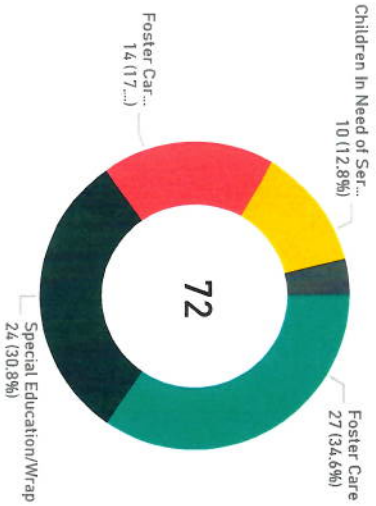

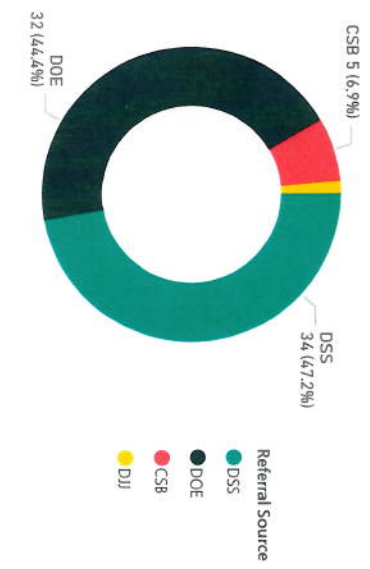

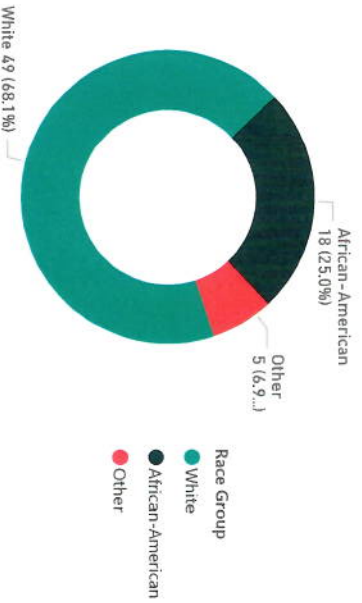
Distinct Child Count By Mandate Type

Distinct Child Count By Expenditure Code



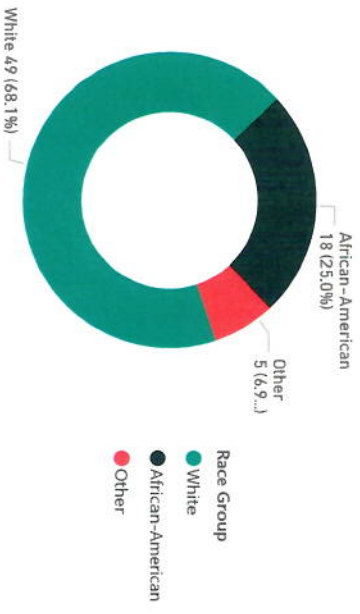

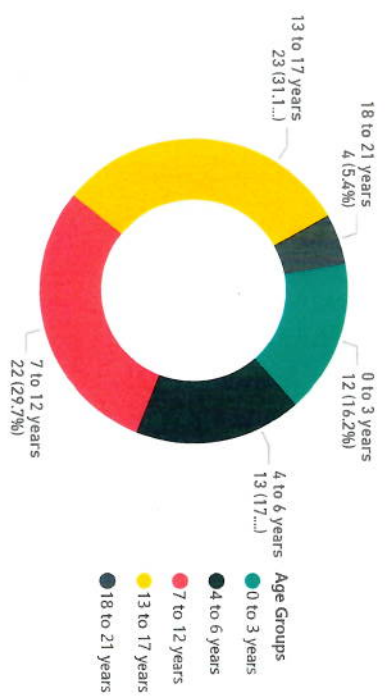

What percentage of each cohort improved between their earliest Initial and most recent Reassessment/Discharge CANS?

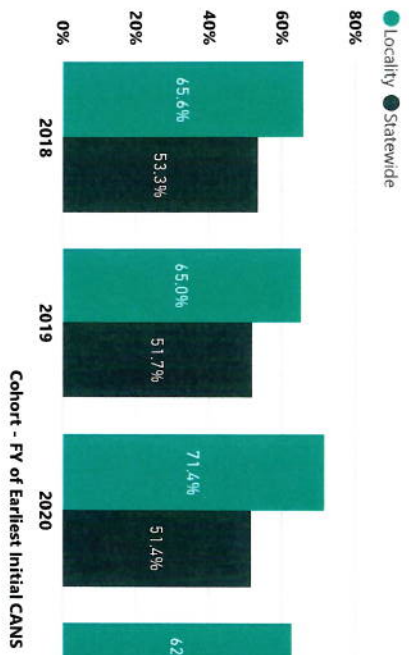

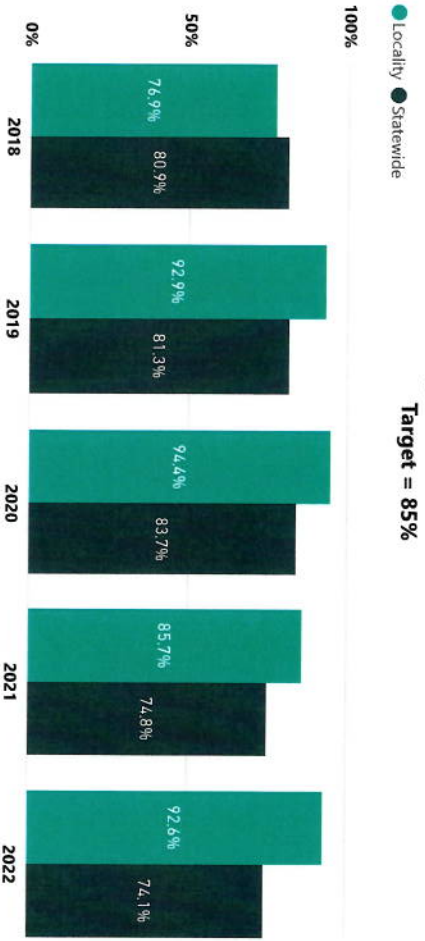

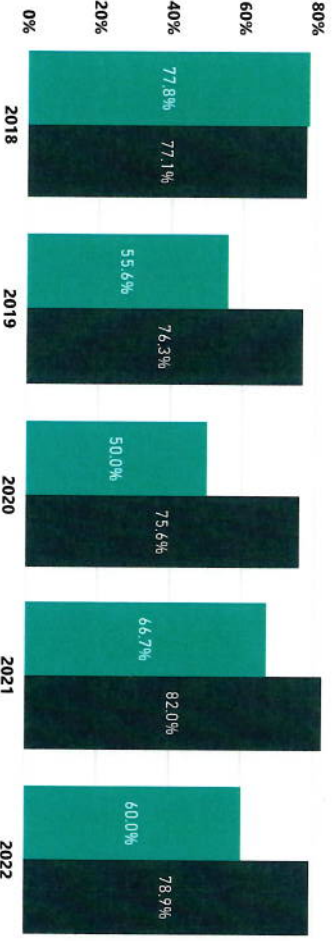

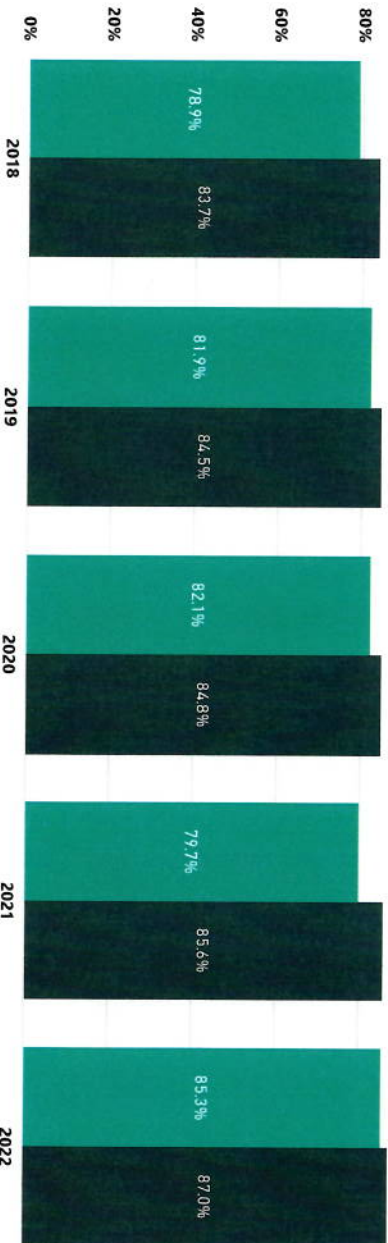
