DISASTER CONTINGENCY PLAN

RiverStreet Networks maintains a Disaster Response and Recovery Plan as well as a Business Continuity Plan. RiverStreet's Chief Technology Officer aligns resources across all department heads to activate these plans. Severe weather events, natural disasters, and occurrences of force majeure are some of the situations whereby these plans are activated.

RiverStreet's physical infrastructure building and site access is secured with dual-factor authentication. IP camera surveillance is implemented at each property where infrastructure facilities and employees are present. Critical IT infrastructure, including servers, network elements, and monitoring systems are protected in areas with dual-factor authentication. Default usernames and passwords are disabled or removed and United States DoD password guidelines are followed.

IT systems are kept up-to-date on patches and software updates. Penetration tests are performed by internal and subcontracted IT resources. Corrections and improvements are made upon test results.

Any IT policies breached result in disciplinary action up to termination of employment.
